If your family currently has an open WI Shares Case (W-2 Childcare Reimbursement Voucher Program), all you need to do is call **1-888-947-6583** to update your authorization. You may experience a brief waiting period when making this call. You can avoid the wait by going to the Coggs Center (1200 W. Vliet St.) - Window 200E (take the escalator to the second floor) to update your authorization in person. They will ask you to provide your summer program provider and location number.
