- Training at Cutting Edge will last four weeks from Monday through Friday.
- Additional employment training prep will be held at BGCGM's The Ready Center, 1916 N. Vel R. Phillips Ave., Milwaukee, 53212 for three weeks
- There is no cost for this program, tuition and supplies will be provided
- Classes run every 6 weeks

- First Aid Certification
